

RECREATIONAL FISHING LICENCE

In order to carry out recreational fishing in the marine waters of Madeira, the practitioner or vessel must be licenced monthly/annually by the Regional Fisheries Directorate (the invoice-receipt of said licencing is valid as a licence).

(Licences issued for recreational fishing in mainland Portugal are not valid in Madeira.)

* The harvesting of limpets for family purposes in land or sea areas is exempt from any license, (with a limit of 3kg / day /person).

DAILY CATCH LIMITS

Legally established limits on daily catch according to the modality practised, the number of practitioners and the species caught.

*The harvest of limpets is prohibited between the 1st of November and the 31th of March, which corresponds to the closed season.

LEGALLY REQUIRED MINIMUM SIZES

► In the case of recreational fishing, it is forbidden to retain on board, unload, transport, or store specimens of certain species that do not meet the legally established minimum size.

► The list of minimum sizes of fish, crustaceans and molluscs is set out in Annex II of Ordinance No 484/2016 of 14 November.

According to ICCAT recommendations the legal minimum sizes are:

*Atlantic Blue Marlin (*Makaira nigricans*) 251 cm;
Atlantic White Marlin (*Tetrapturus albidus*) 168 cm);

SPECIES WHICH ARE PROHIBITED TO CATCH AND RETAIN FOR THIS TYPE OF FISHING

► The capture or retention of certain specimens in recreational fishing is prohibited.

► The list of species whose capture and retention is prohibited is set out in Annex I of Ordinance No. 484/2016 of 14 November.

The specie *Isurus oxyrinchus* is prohibited to catch, retain on board, transport or unload.

*In recreational fishing the capture of species prohibited in commercial fishing is not allowed. Check the table that Directorate-General for Natural Resources, Safety and Maritime Services provides (dgrm.mm.gov.pt) > Fisheries > professional Fishing > Species/minimum sizes/Closed Seasons > Table with the summary of prohibited species.
